

## COACHING DIRECTOR

- The Coaching Director is responsible for the management of the Club's coaching program and promoting the value of coaching within the Club.

### SKILL SET

- Has leadership skills
- Has good motivational and communication skills
- Is able to evaluate coach performance and provide positive feedback/advice/evaluation
- Maintains or improves his/her accreditation level
- Has a sound understanding of modern coaching and teaching principals
- Has a sound understanding of the Club's/Local League's/Divisions rules & regulations



## DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- ✓ In conjunction with League/NRL coordinator, ensure all coaches hold appropriate qualifications/accreditations
- ✓ Ensure there are enough coaches for the Club's requirements
- ✓ Provide all relevant information to the Secretary to ensure records of club coaches & their accreditations are maintained
- ✓ Arrange appropriate coach training sessions
- ✓ Be available to assist at games, if necessary
- ✓ Foster a positive club spirit amongst all coaches and encourage them to participate in a sporting manner
- ✓ Enhance feelings of self confidence and self-esteem within the club's coaches
- ✓ Encourage maximum participation from the club's coaches
- ✓ Liaise with the Club Executive regularly
- ✓ Highlight the club's support of the NRL National Code of Conduct and the NRL Safeplay Code
- ✓ Identify and seek potential coaches and recruit whenever possible
- ✓ Offer support, direction and advice to coaches where necessary or if requested
- ✓ Provide coaches with an up-to-date coaching manual and encourage coaches to complete program planning and required documentation
